I want to go to Lenhok'sin this summer! I understand that attending High Adventure trips is a privilege, and that I must meet certain expectations or I will not be allowed to attend this activity.

I understand that

- This trip is currently planned for ~~July 26 through August 1~~ July 19 through July 25, 2009.
- Working together as a crew and learning backpacking skills are essential to this trip. I will attend the shakedown hikes on March 28-29, April 18-19, and May 22-24. They are not optional. If an emergency arises and I cannot attend a shakedown hike, I will discuss this with Mr. Schimke to determine if I may still attend Lenhok'sin.
- This trip is an addition to and not a replacement for my normal scouting activities. I will be active in regular troop activities.
- The total cost of this trip is estimated to be \$350. The exact amount will be determined by May 4.
- A \$50 deposit is required by March 5, 2009, to hold my place on this trip.
- The second payment of \$275 is due on April 9. If I am late with this payment, I understand that there will be an additional \$50 (second payment amount increases to \$325) added to the cost if it is paid before June 18. The additional charge will increase to \$75 (the second payment amount increases to \$350) if paid after June 18.
- The third payment is due June 18. The amount has not yet been determined, but is estimated at \$25.
- The cost for food on our shakedown hikes is not included in the above prices.
- I understand that I will need to buy or borrow the backpacking gear required for this trip if I don't already own all that I will need.
- I must be at least a First Class scout before the first day of the trip.
- I must be at least 13 years old by July 1, 2009.
- I must turn in a medical form (the "new" 2009 form or an old Class 3) before the May shakedown hike.
- While on the shakedown hikes I must demonstrate to my adult leaders and fellow crew members that I am willing and physically able to participate in this activity.
- As a High Adventure crew member, I am a representative of Troop 1097, the IWLA, and the Boy Scouts of America. If my behavior before or during this high adventure trip does not reflect the Scout Law in a positive manner, I will not be allowed to participate in this activity, and I understand that money I've paid is not refundable.
